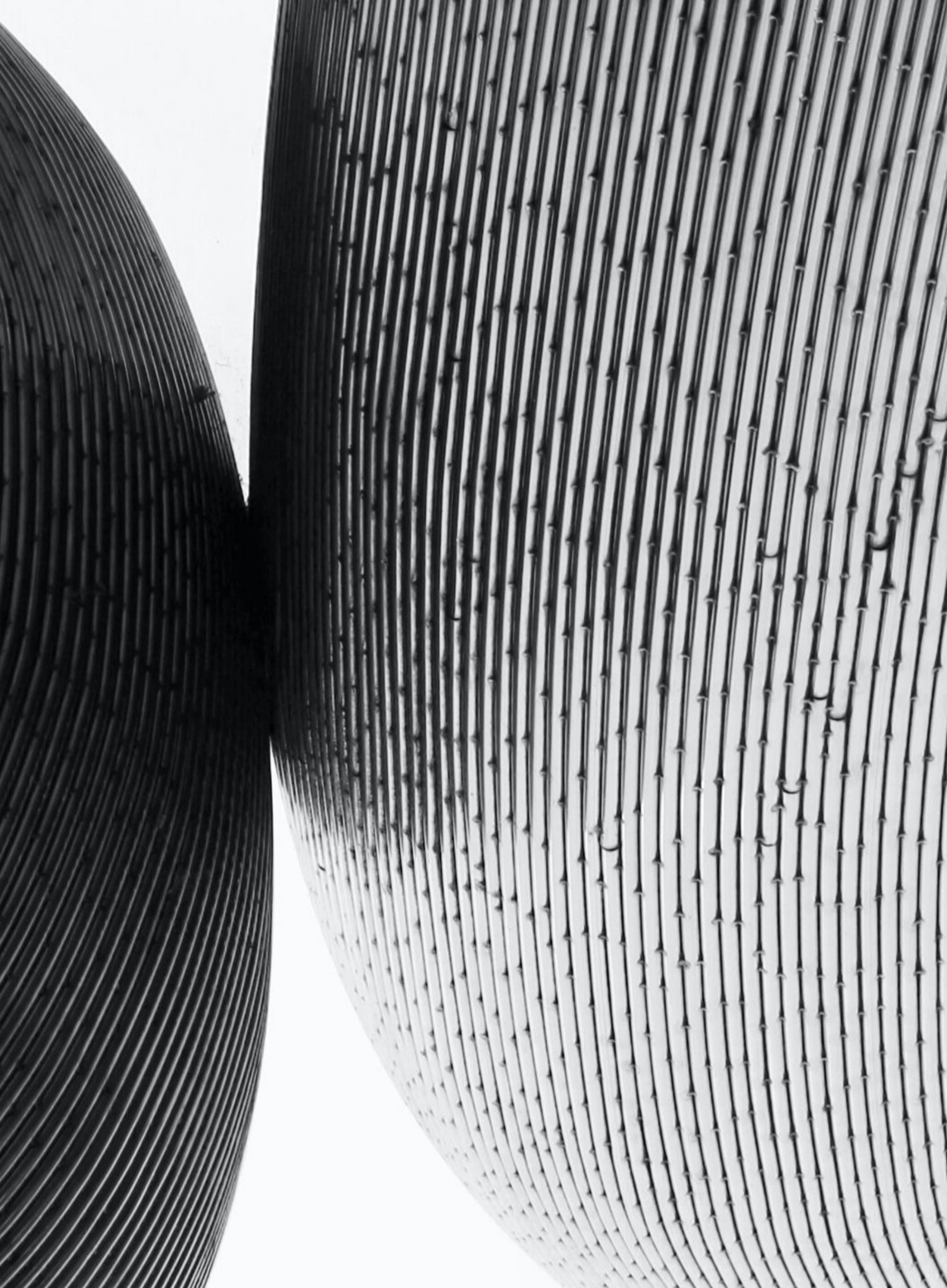

The company's history



1950

Founder Nikolaos Skoubourdis started with a small carpentry workshop in Kalymnos, crafting doors, kitchens, and furniture.

1981

Second Generation: Agapitos and Sakellarios established S. Skoubourdis & Co. OE, expanding to new privately-owned facilities of 1,500 sq.m.

1985

Upgraded with state-of-the-art equipment. Adopted modern production methods, focusing on wooden frames, kitchens, and furniture while entering the hotel furnishing industry.

1990

Launched an exhibition space in Kalymnos.

1994

The company embraced CNC (Computerized Numerical Control) technology, marking the beginning of a new era. Upgraded its vehicle fleet with four new freight trucks and employee transport vehicles.

2000

Expanded the wooden frame production line with new equipment. Achieved ISO 9001 & 14001 certifications.

2004

Following this continuous growth, company's headquarters moved to a new, state-of-the-art facility in Kos, covering 5,000 sq.m., with a focus on hotel furniture and high-volume production.

2007

Company was restructured, leading to the creation of Vestal, marking the beginning of a new journey. Management transitioned to the third generation, led by the children of Agapitos Skoubourdis, Nikolas and George.

2009

CE Certification: Vestal earned CE certification for wooden frames' and doors' production.

2012

Introduced new production lines for solid wood and melamine processing.

2014

Acquired a modern robotic painting unit for furniture and frames.

2015

Upgraded its vehicle fleet with four new freight trucks and employee transport vehicles.

2017

Achieved ISO 9001 & 14001 certifications.

2019

Strengthened projects' department with new personnel, including design analysts. Acquired SolidWorks® software to provide high-level services to clients.

2021

A modern exhibition space of 2,500 sq.m. was also created.
